to The South Brazil Mission, 1921.

Cuyaba

During our four months language study in

Sao Paulo we had the privilege of supplying the pulpit in the Braz Church each Sunday morning besides working in the Sunday School and visiting among the people. Yet for all that, we had the feeling of one who draws near to home after a period of absence, as we embarked at Cerumba for the last stage of our thirty five day trip, from Castro, Parana to Cuyaba, Matto Grosso.

As to the work in Northern Matto Grosso, outside of three trips to one of the out-stations and one to the Chapada, we have been confined to Cuyaba since our return. The trip to the Chapada was to examine an estate called "Burity" and find out the possibilities of buying the place.

'Burity' is about thirty miles from Cuyaba and is situated on the high tableland to the north of Cuyaba - The Chapada. The Chapada is about a thousand feet above Cuyaba and the climate is much better than the low country. The estate - Burity - contains over twelve thousand acres, well watered and wooded. Waterpower is sufficient for all and any needs that may arise as the school develops. The road that connects the estate with Cuyaba is just a regular mule trail and needs a lot of repairing especially in the mountain region. The heirs of the estate - They are many - wish 16:500\$000 (sixteen centos five hundred milreis for the land and improvements. I am planning to buy.

It is the the sound of -A grande amen- that we note that the manse for Cuyaba is in the Preferred List for new property this year.

If for any reason Mr Phillip Landes should decide not to continue his medical course, the call for a doctor for the place should be reiterated with emphasis.

The great need of one more travelling evangelist

to work the Paraguay and the Guyaba River is pressing .Owing to the e  
extreme long distances the man stationed at Guyaba cannot cover the f  
field.
